Saturday 10:00 AM—11:00 AM

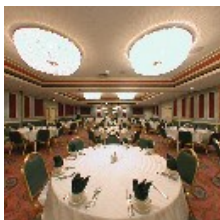
Annual Stoddard Alumni Meeting in hospitality room. Election of officers and normal business.

Saturday 12:00 A M —4:00 PM

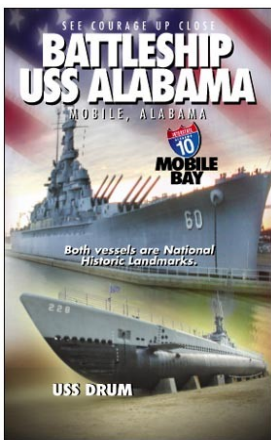

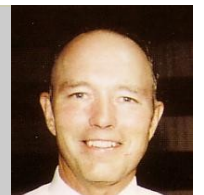
